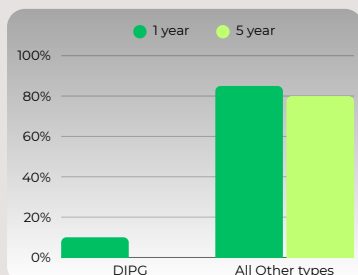


EVERY 2 MINUTES A CHILD IS DIAGNOSED WITH CANCER

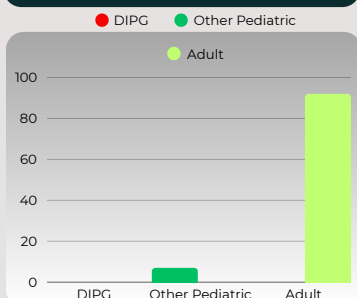
WHY SUPPORT DIPG CHILDHOOD CANCER

#1 disease-related cause of death in children



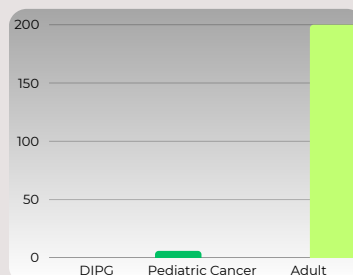
Survival

DIPG has a 0% survival rate



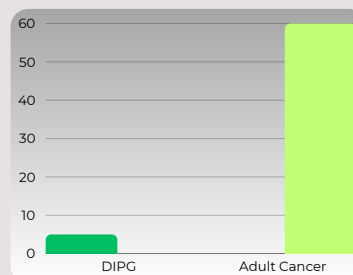
Federal Funding

Research Investment - \$130K
